SENIOR FREEZE (PTR FORMS)

THE DEADLINE FOR 2022 APPLICATIONS IS OCTOBER 31, 2023.

WHICH FORM TO USE.

PTR-1 - If you met the eligibility requirements for both 2021 & 2022 are filing for the first time (or reapplying to the program after being denied in a prior year), file FORM PTR-1 and the appropriate verification form (PTR-1A/PTR-1B).

PTR-2 - If you filed an application for 2021 and met all the eligibility requirements, file Form PTR-2 and the appropriate verification form (PTR-2A/2B). Form **PTR-2 is a personalized application that is not available online. If you qualify and have not received this application, call 1-800-882-6597.**

The verification form is your proof of property taxes due and paid. Alternate documents to send as proof can be found in the Senior Freeze FAQ located online at NJ Division of Taxation—Senior Freeze.

****STATEMENT OR PRINTOUT SIGNED BY THE CO-OP MANAGER** - Instead of filling out Form PTR-1A Co-op, or PTR-2A Co-op, your Co-op office may provide a letter on co-op letterhead signed by the manager or a printout that details the share of property taxes paid for each type of residential unit. The letter or printout must specify the unit occupied by the applicant and the share of property taxes due and paid for that residential unit. Your CV4 Office has printouts available at the office. Please feel free to come or call the office, provide your information and the printout will be available to you that day.

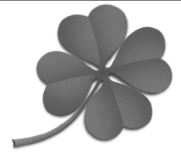

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The Rep Report March 2023

Hello again. It's my sincere hope you're all having a good 2023. Welcome to our new members! I'm Carol Marsella, and I chair the CV Four District Representatives (a.k.a. district reps, or reps). Given it's been a while since I've written for our column, and a certain few questions pop up, it occurs to me to address the most common ones here.

What is a district rep?

A District Representative is a volunteer liaison who will act between resident and board of trustees on behalf of each to the other. We are well versed in CV Four rules, regulations, and by-laws, as well as local happenings, contacts, activities, news, and more. It's our goal and responsibility to ease the burden of assisting the individual unit owner, while the board of trustees carries the massive burden of assisting the village as a whole.

Are they village cops?

While reps certainly help maintain a moderate degree of security, we are not here to enforce. We do, however, like to stop by to introduce ourselves when we see you outside, and we might, on occasion, offer a gentle reminder or clarification about some bylaw or rule that appears to have been forgotten or overlooked. It's rare, but it does happen. We know the area and will make note to question something that looks odd or out of place.

How many district reps are there?

Currently, we have 10 district reps covering 1,189 homes. Yes, we represent you all. **No certificate holder is without a rep.**

Does a District rep get paid?

District Rep is a volunteer position. Neither the Chair nor any reps are ever paid for their service.

When should I call my district rep?

We're here to help with any questions you might have about our village four and/or Manchester. Co-op residency is different from any other; it can be confusing at times. It's always best to call us when you're unsure of how to go about something (modifications, common area, how to park extended visitors, and all the whys and wherefores that concern or confuse). What we do ask, though, is that you reach out to us between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. unless there is an emergency.

What if no district rep is assigned to my address? Am I on my own?

All certificate holders are represented. Even those of us who have assigned areas can -and do - represent those who do not appear with a specific rep's current list.

I'll take this opportunity to mention we are seeking volunteers to join us. So if you're interested in learning more about CV Four and would like to help your friends and neighbors as defined in this article, my contact information is at the bottom. Please reach out to me.

What if I can't reach my rep?

We're all listed in the rep section of this newsletter. Call Carol (me) or any other rep.

How does one become a district rep? What are the requirements? Are there shifts? What's the time commitment?

Glad you asked! One would call or email me and share your interest. We will arrange a time to meet at the clubhouse and there is a 1.5 to 2 hour training/information meeting at a time convenient to all. The main requirement is you must be a certificate holder and a resident of CV Four. The only time requirement is our mandatory monthly meeting which is the second Thursday of every month at the clubhouse at 1:00 p.m.

There are no shifts. We are a 24/7 commitment (this is referencing emergency situations) Emergencies are rare but they do happen. We request and are afforded the courtesy of receiving most of our calls between 9 and 4. Our residents know we are volunteers, and most are very respectful that way.

Do reps get calls all day long?

Not at all. We can go days or weeks without an inquiry. That said, they tend to come in spurts. After a snowfall, for example, or during a power outage. And that's as it should be. The trustees advise us, and we are ready to share info with all of you.

Do I have to stay at home? I go out of town a lot to see family. Not at all. Reps are not chained to the village. Just let me know when you're not in town and another rep will step in for you.

I do want to add one very important note of suggestion. And that is, please add your rep's and my phone number to your directory and cell phone, and label it with our names and "District Rep". **This will be most helpful if there is an emergency and we need to reach you. You will recognize the number and not ignore the call.**

I hope I have answered these questions well and that this information is helpful. The most important take away - and please let others know - is that your district reps are here for ALL CERTIFICATE HOLDERS. Reminder: Ask Your District Representative **FIRST**

The primary duty of the Representative is to work together with the Board of Trustees, to establish an appropriate link with and among the residents to further the smooth-running operation of an informed and harmonious community.
