

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE (by Donna Golding, President) JOIN US FOR OUR 50TH ANNIVERSARY KICK OFF WITH MAYOR ARACE - MONDAY, MARCH 18TH AT 6PM!!!

Recyclables – Recycling Services are Provided by Central Jersey Waste. According to Central Jersey Waste: "You may place recyclables curbside the night before your scheduled day, in the proper container (plastic containers preferred). PLEASE DO NOT PLACE RECYCLABLES IN PAPER BAGS, PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES." "Crushed (not tied) cardboard boxes, 2'x2' square, may be placed at curbside with your recyclables. Mixed paper, junk mail, magazines, used writing paper, white envelopes & computer paper must be placed in a reusable container." CV4 has been receiving complaints from residents about recyclables strewn and blown onto Village streets. To avoid this, put a top on containers. This will also keep the items from falling out of and blowing around the Village. If needed, put a brick or something that will secure the recyclables in the bin to try to prevent the items from blowing onto your neighboring space. If you are looking for a new container there are some that have locking lids that will keep items in the container even if the container falls. Remember, recycling receptacles, such as metal or plastic cans may not be placed along the outside walls of dwelling units. 4-6-8 plexes are exempt due to limited space.

The people from Manchester that collect the recycling DO NOT pick up the debris scattered along the roadway or property.

Curbside Debris – Begins the FIRST Wednesday in March (March 6th). If you are putting items out to the curb please keep those items on the grass. This is very important in the months where we could experience SNOW, because it makes plowing hazardous. This also makes it difficult for cars to park at the maintenance will curb. Also, do not place debris in bags, not pick it up. **Pets** - Picking up after your pets is a community-wide issue which results in <u>many</u> resident complaints. Having a pet comes with the responsibility of cleaning up after your pet. When walking your pet on the roadways in our Village, pets shall not be walked in wooded areas adjacent to or between buildings or on common grounds. All solid waste MUST be picked up immediately and MAY NOT be disposed of in street basins or in other resident's garbage pails. If the waste is not in a bag and tossed in the pail, it will not be collected by maintenance. Put waste in a garbage bag, same as your house trash. ALSO, pet are NOT permitted to be tied outside or and/or left unattended. This is against the Rules and Regulations and will result in a warning and/or fine.

AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL OF HOA PAYMENTS (ACH)

In a further attempt to keep our residents informed, I would like to take this time to first apologize to our residents whose funds are automatically withdrawn from your bank accounts to pay your monthly HOA fees for the frustration and confusion you have been experiencing regarding the delay of the withdrawal of your funds from your bank account. At our Resident's Meeting on February 8th, residents who participate in the automatic withdrawal, or ACH payments, asked why there have been delays with the money being withdrawn from their accounts. While the charges were applied in our system, the bank did not withdraw the funds from your accounts in a timely manner. Obviously no late fees are being charged, and the Board of Trustees and I understand the frustration and confusion this causes. On Friday, February 23rd, the Board of Trustees met with members from Ocean First Bank to address this issue, the lack of communication between the bank and the office when this occurs, and how we can avoid a repeat going forward. The meeting was productive and a system has been put in place where the bank will communicate with me directly if the payments do not get withdrawn. Additionally, they have provided me with access to our online ACH processing system, so after the charges are applied in our system, I can immediately go online to ensure bank has processed the withdrawals on their end. I am optimistic that we will not encounter any further issues, and will be diligent in ensuring your funds are withdrawn in a timely manner. It usually takes about 2 days from the date the charges are applied in our system for the bank to withdraw your funds. I intend on applying the charges on March 4th, which means they should be withdrawn from your accounts by March 6th.

COUPON BOOKS

Another issue I would like to address is your coupon books. This year, many residents received coupon books, regardless if they use ACH or pay by check. **IF** your monthly payments are scheduled to be automatically withdrawn from your account, you **DO NOT** have to submit a check and/or use your coupons. <u>The coupons are for those residents who pay by check ONLY</u>.

The Board and your office staff are working hard to address and resolve all issues as they arise. I want to personally thank you all for your patience, and want you to know your office staff is here to assist you in every way possible.

SENIOR FREEZE (PTR FORMS)

The Senior Freeze Program reimburses eligible senior citizens and disabled persons for property tax or mobile home park site fee increases on their principal residence (main home). To qualify, you must meet all the eligibility requirements for each year from the base year through the application year. NJ State Government began mailing applications on February 12, 2024. If you do not receive your booklet by late March, you may contact them at 1-800-882-6597.

First-time filers or those who must reestablish a base year may <u>print the</u> <u>PTR-1 application and/or instructions</u> on <u>https://www.nj.gov/treasury/taxation/ptr/</u> <u>index.shtml</u>.

The deadline for 2023 application is October 31, 2024.

2023 payments to qualified applicants will begin in July.

WHICH FORM TO USE:

PTR-I-If you met the eligibility requirements for both 2022 & 2023, are filing for the first time (or reapplying to the program after being denied in a prior year), file FORM PTR-I and the appropriate verification form (PTR-IA/PTR -IB).

<u>PTR-2</u> –If you filed an application for 2022 and met all the eligibility requirements, file Form PTR-2 and the appropriate verification form (PTR-2A/2B). Form **PTR-2** is a personalized application that is <u>not</u> available online. If you qualify and have not received this application, call I-800-882-6597.

The verification form is your proof of property taxes due and paid. Alternate documents to send as proof can be found in the Senior Freeze FAQ located online at NJ Division of Taxation - Senior Freeze.

The Co-Op Office only requires your PTR form to complete your property tax information. You may submit your form to the office between the hours of 9am and 2pm. Please allow at least one week for the form to be completed and indicate if you would like to pick it up or have it mailed to you. Thank you.

ANNUAL POST-TAX YEAR INCOME STATEMENT (Form PD5)...WHAT IS IT AND DO I QUALIFY?

Many residents have been calling to find out what the Annual Post-Tax Year Income Statement is. According to nj.gov treasury taxation, "the Annual Post-Tax Year Income Statement of Qualified New Jersey Resident Senior Citizen, Disabled Person, or Surviving Spouse/Surviving Civil Union Partner Required to Continue Receipt of Real Property Tax Deduction on Dwelling House. On or before March 1st of the post-tax year, deduction recipients MUST file this Income Statement with the municipal tax collector to confirm that annual income for the preceding tax year DID NOT exceed the \$10,000 limit, after permitted income exclusion, and that anticipated income for the current tax year will NOT exceed \$10,000. The applicable income period is the same tax year as the tax year for which the deduction was claimed or received."

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HOPA - 2024 AGE VERIFICATION SURVEY FORM
